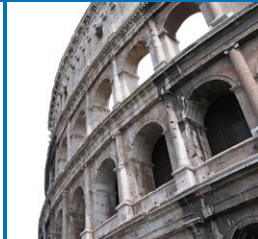

## Basic Italian 1

Greetings and introducing oneself, asking for information.

## Basic Italian 2

Describing oneself, talking about likes and dislikes, asking for and giving information using the past tense.

## Basic Italian 3

Talking about the weather, food and restaurants.

## Basic Italian Review

The grammatical structures include a review of the grammar learned in Basic Italian 1, 2 & 3, and combined with a basic conversation.

## Intermediate Italian 1

Talking about the environment, cinema, sport and free time.

## Intermediate Italian 2

Talking about politics and social and multicultural problems.

## Advanced Italian 1

Students will review the grammatical structures learned in the past and will be exposed to more sophisticated constructions.

## Advanced Italian 2

Students will have opportunities to apply their knowledge of the Italian language to literature and cultural and social topics.
